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The Widder Hotel in Zurich: A synthesis of the arts between heritage and modernity. Situated in the heart of the historic district of Zurich, The Widder Hotel fascinates visitors from all over the world through its distinctive ambience and since the opening of this very special hotel in 1995 its attraction never fails. The Five-star property unfolds itself in an ensemble of nine historical residences from the Middle Ages, whose unique flair has been combined with timeless elements in meticulous restoration. The UBS, owner of the estate, developed the exclusive property through a ten year elaborate renovation project. The Widder Hotel is a member of Leading Small Hotels of the World as well as Swiss Deluxe Hotels and Design Hotels. Each of the Widder Hotel's nine houses was once a living space of its own, and even today not one room is like the other. Under the direction of Swiss Star-Architect and Interior Designer Mrs Tilla Theus hundreds of builders and artisans embedded the medieval heritage in her inspired room concept, which releases new, surprising details and perspectives. The Widder Hotel owes its name to one

of the nine houses: the historical Haus zur Widderzunft, home of the butcher's guild since 1401, still today the meeting place for traditional events. There are historical "Grisaille" paintings on the walls of some rooms, referring to the former guild hall from 1678, while other rooms are decorated with precious wooden inlays or delicate nature scenes from the Renaissance. Modern Classics such as chairs and day beds by Le Corbusier, Mies van der Rohe, Eileen Gray, Charles and Roy Eames fit artfully into Tilla Theus' extraordinary interior design. Precious antiques, masterpieces and works of art of the world's renown, mostly contemporary artists underline the property's distinctive accents and features. Paintings and sculptures adorn the lobby, the restaurants, conference rooms as well as all guest rooms. In this environment the Widder Hotel's masterpieces can be experienced in a totally private atmosphere, like no museum can ever provide. Without losing its claim of artistic autonomy, the collection complements the interior design through careful composition. Paintings such as Max Bill's abstract "rays of blue in yellow," Michael Gasser's blue dream of "Nikkaia," Serge Poliakoff's "Composition bleue et rouge" or the exclusively created work by American Pop Art artist Robert Rauschenberg expresses the sophistication of the collection. Some of the works represent the heraldic animal of the hotel such as Andy Warhol's "Ram," Roberto Benazzi's ram-"Sculpture 2 Homme" as well as the untitled abstract reference by Sophie Taeuber-Arp. The Widder Restaurant and its Turmstübli are celebrated as one of the best hotel cuisines in Zurich. Delicious Swiss specialties are also served in the Wirtschaft zur Schtund. The Widder Hotel's culinary experience starts in the stylish atmosphere of the Widder restaurants with sophisticated table settings and precious chinaware, on which the newest creations are presented by the Executive Chef. Hotel guests also enjoy the fabulous "Wytresor" - the wine cellar of the Widder Restaurant, which offers a precious selection of fine international wines as well as an exquisite range from the region. In decor and furnishings all three restaurants combine modern elements with the cosiness of historical wooden ceilings and pillars. For instance in the Turmstübli the remainders of a wall mural were discovered during the renovation, revealing a tiny flushing owl from the 15th century. The Widder Bar's "Library of Spirits" offers more than 800 spirits and a sensational collection of 250 different Single Malt whiskeys. Highly popular with Zurich's society, the bar's interior is characterized by Raffael Benazzi's modern ram sculpture, but also by the cosy architectural charm of old wooden beams from the year 1291, which is a rare example of construction techniques in the Middle Ages. The comprehensive hotel library "Turicensia" is located on the ground floor of the Steinhaus. Its inventory is dedicated predominantly to Zurich. Hundreds of coffee-table books, art- and history-guides as well as selected poetry and fiction offer the reader a wide variety of the city and its surroundings.

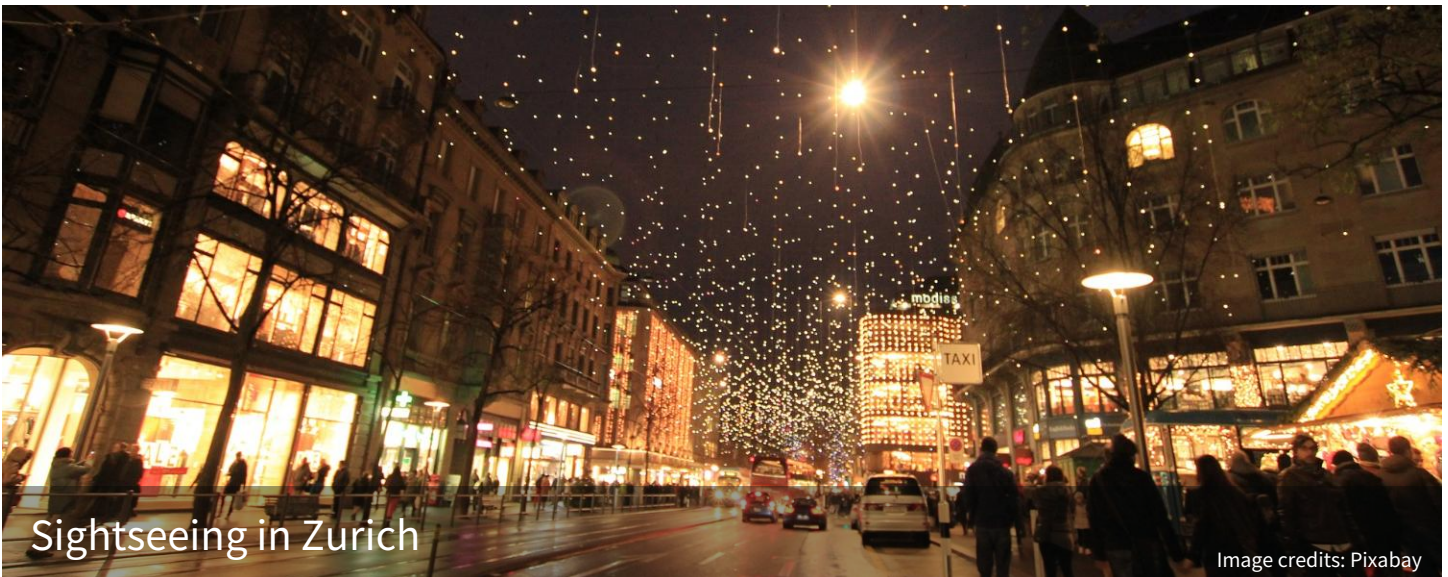

The walking tour will give you a good general idea of Zurich in all its aspects like the business and shopping center (famous Bahnhofstrasse) and the Old town. Continue to the vantage point Lindenhof beneath this elevated square in the city center are the ruins of a Roman customs post, and a late Roman fortress. This spot also offers magnificent views over the old town. Continue to Neumarkt (New Market) which in the old days was located just outside the old city walls and Spiegelgasse. You will also see the Grossmünster the symbol of the city with its distinctive twin towers, and St. Peters the biggest church clock face in Europe. See the Town Hall, Zürich's baroque town dating back to 1694. The tour will end at the Schipfe a street of artisans at the river Limmat in one of Zürich's oldest districts. Whether at Zurich's oldest Christmas market in the picturesque Old Town, at the urban "Wienachtsdorf" Christmas village on Sechseläutenplatz near Bellevue, or next to the 15-meter (49 ft) tall sparkling Christmas tree at the Christkindlimarkt at Zurich Main Train Station: In Zurich, there is a Christmas market to suit each and every taste. A huge choice of gifts and gift ideas enchants visitors to the beautifully decorated market stands. During a stroll through the Christmas market, there is also plenty of opportunity to warm up with a glass of punch (for the children) or mulled wine (for the adults), or a hot bite to eat, such as raclette or fondue. The Christmas markets in the city of Zurich, as well as in the region around Lake Zurich, are especially inviting and multifaceted, with the result that every visitor is guaranteed to find their own particular favorite.

The Kunsthhaus Zürich is home to one of Switzerland's most important art collections, with around 4,000 paintings and sculptures as well as 95,000 prints and drawings from the 13th century to the present day. Around 10% of them are on permanent display. After a 2013 exhibition of the Looser Collection centred around the large-format paintings and sculptures, this second presentation focuses on the dialogue between the extensive holdings of works on paper and sculptures that coordinate with them. It explores the play of lines and textures on the blank surface of the drawing paper and so brings us closer to the sculptures' presence in space. The exhibition includes over 80 key works of Surrealism, Abstract Expressionism, Nouveau Réalisme, Pop Art and Minimal Art, Arte Povera and more; the artists include David Smith, Serge Brignoni, Pablo Picasso, Yves Klein, Willem de Kooning, Anthony Caro, Richard Serra, Brice Marden, Sean Scully and Giuseppe Penone.

The Matterhorn ski paradise covers an area from the Rothorn paradise (3103 m) and the Gornergrat (3089 m) to Matterhorn glacier paradise (Klein Matterhorn) (3883 m) and Schwarzsee paradise (2583 m). It connects from Matterhorn glacier paradise to Breuil-Cervinia / Valtournenche and Val d'Aoste. There are three ways for skiers and snowboarders to reach Zermatt's winter sports area. Access to the Rothorn paradise winter sports area and the free-ride Stockhorn area is via the Rothorn paradise resort station. The Gornergrat winter sports area is reached via the resort station of the Gornergrat Bahntransport system. The Matterhorn Express takes winter sports enthusiasts from the Matterhorn glacier paradise resort station to Schwarzsee paradise or Matterhorn glacier paradise, connecting with Breuil-Cervinia / Valtournenche (Italy).

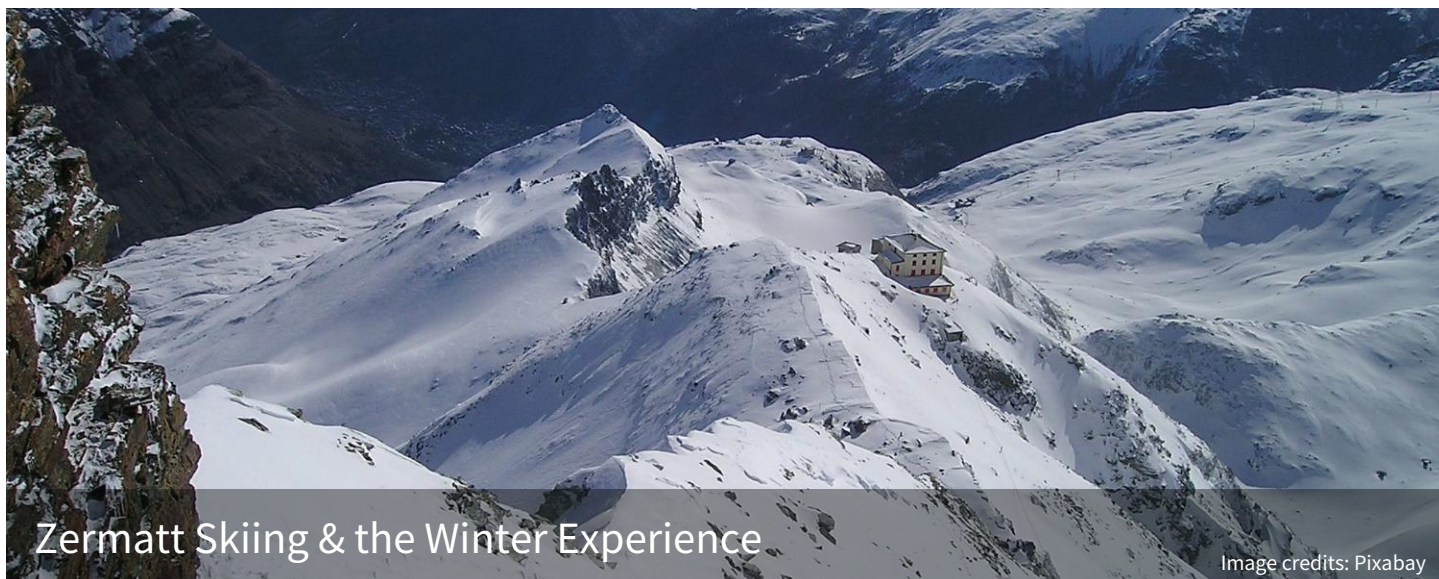

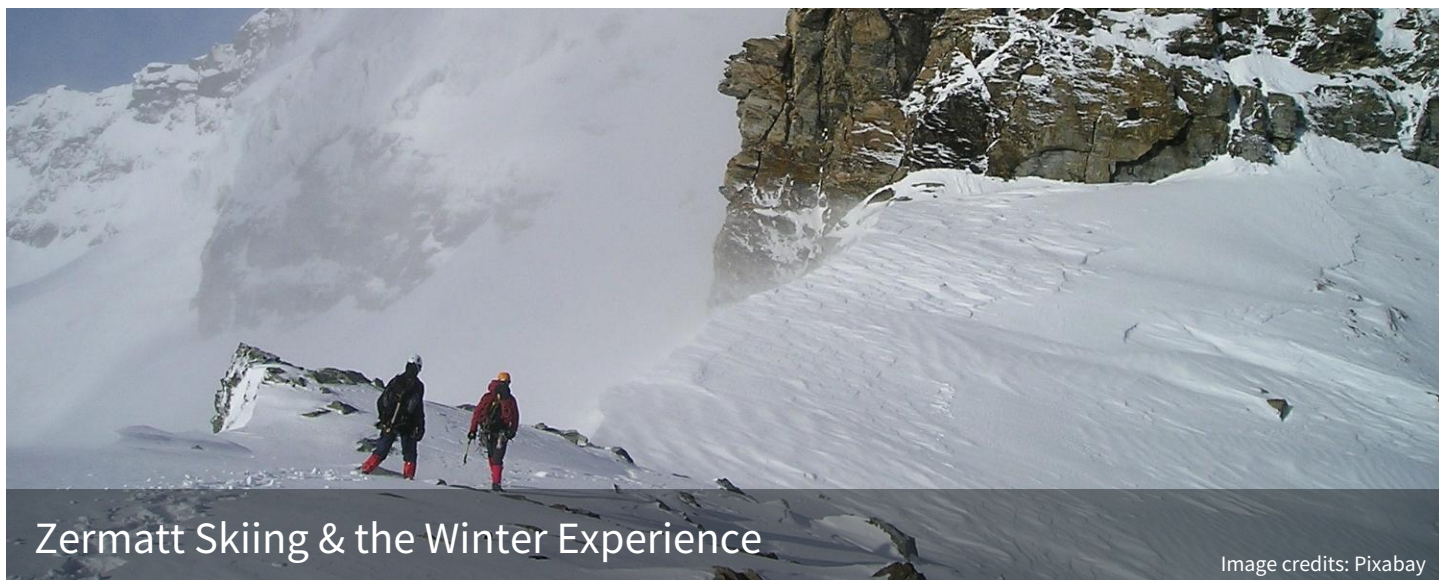

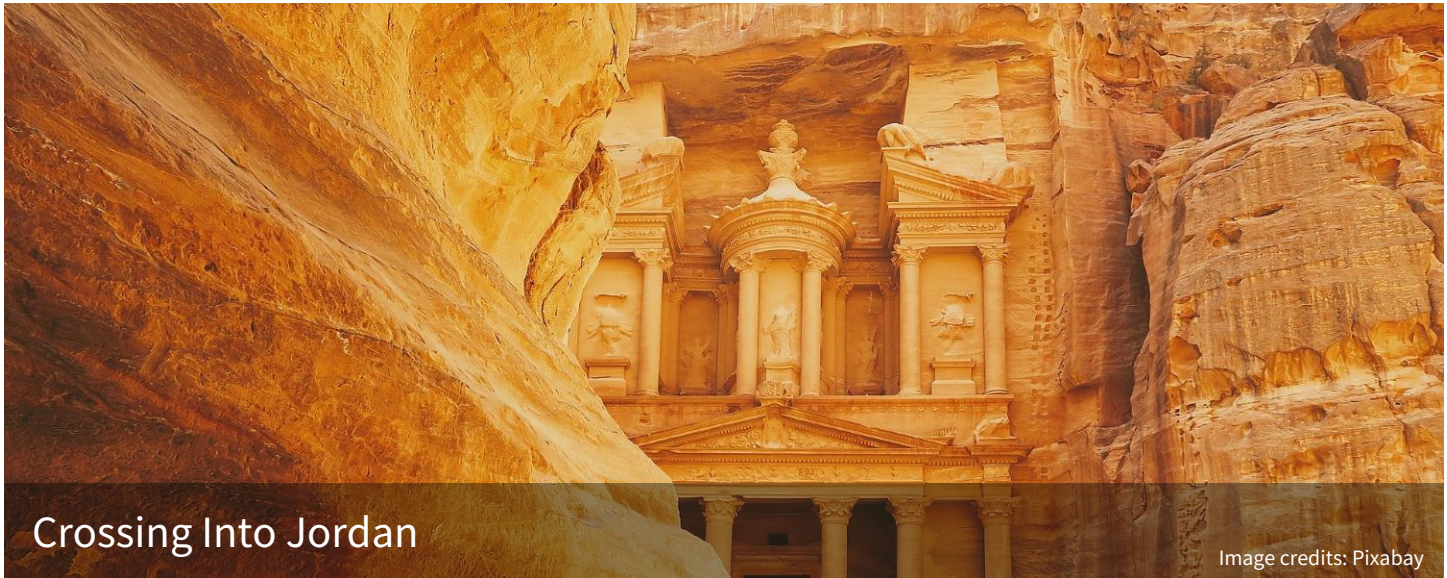

Early this morning at 6:00 a.m., a Mabat driver will transfer you to Ben Gurion airport for your domestic flight to Eilat (approximately an hour-long flight). On arrival in Eilat, you will be assisted with arrival procedures and escorted to your awaiting driver for the transfer to the Arava border to cross over into Jordan. Beyond El Khazneh, as you enter deeper into the city, you will be surrounded on both sides by hundreds of carved and built structures, soaring temples, elaborate royal tombs, a carved Roman theatre, banquet halls, water channels, public buildings and much more. Lunch is included for you today in Petra. You will leave Petra the same way you entered. Head south and return to the Arava border checkpoint and cross over into Israel (bid farewell to your guide, driver and security guard). At the border, our representative will await you on the Israeli side to transfer you to the Eilat airport where you will be assisted with departure procedures.
